
- Create an actionable blueprint for use by the city of Newton to • understand the desires of Waban citizens covering:



• "...[T]he most tranquil and lonely reach between the Upper and Lower Falls, amid the most idyllic rural scenery." (King's Guide to Newton)






Demographic Changes



Age Distribution for 02468 Show Data



Household Income for 02468 Show Data




Marital Status for 02468 Residents Show Data




